Transit Accessibility of Minority and Low Income Population in Hartford Area

Minority- Minority is total population (B01001) minus the white alone population (B01001H).

A transit system that covers an area with more than 35.5% minority is considered equitable.

Low Income – Low income is defined as less than 150% of poverty status. Low income population is the summation of B06012002 (Below 100 percent of the poverty level) and B06012003 (100 to 149 percent of the poverty level).

A transit system that covers an area with 11.3% low income population is considered equitable.

Results:

The average percent minority and low income population for the service area using a three quarter mile buffer.

- Percent Minority (0.75 Mile Buffer) = 32.4861%
- Percent Low Income (0.75 Mile Buffer) = 17.7087%

A buffer distance of 1.25 miles was used in addition to 0.75 miles.

The results from the analysis are listed below –

- Percent Minority (0.75 mile) = 32.14862% (Not equitable)
- Percent Minority (0.25 mile) = 32.50314% (Not equitable)
- Percent Low Income (0.75 mile) = 17.70876% (Equitable)
- Percent Low Income (0.25 mile) = 17.79824 % (Equitable)
